	William Easdale Dead. William Easdale, an old and highly respected citizen of Johnson county, died at his home in Olathe, Friday, Jan. 31, and was buried in the Four Corners cemetery Sunday afternoon. Mr. Easdale was 83 years old, and came to Johnson county in an early day, and had an active past in the upbuilding of this part of Kansas. The deceased was the grandfather of our townsman, F. E. Hale, and of Mrs. F. B. Haney, south of town.	Death of Mrs. Rachael Ridlon. Rachael Sutton was born near Rising Sun, Indiana, August 7, 1845 and died April 16, 1923, aged 77 years, eight months and nine days. She was married to Benjamin Wasdale in 1862 and to this union were born two children, both dying in infancy. After seven years of wedded life she was left a widow and later married James Frederick Ridlon at Emporia, Kansas. To this union were born five children: Ida May, who died at the age of 8 years; Mrs. Gussie Vestal, South Pasadena, California; George C. Ridlon, Topeka, Kansas; Lewis Ridlon, Gardner, Kansas, and Mrs. Abbie Millington, Gardner, Kansas. During her early married life she united with the Christian Church. Mrs. Ridlon passed through all the vicissitudes of the pioneer days of Kansas and devoted her life to her children and grand children. She is the last surviving member of her father's family. She passed away at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Carl Millington where she had the kind and loving care of her children, and especially of her sister-in-law, Miss Augusta Ridlon. She was laid to rest beside her husband, the late Fredrick Ridlon. The services were held at the Methodist Church in Gardner, April 18, and interment was made in the Gardner cemetery. —Gardner Gazette.
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
